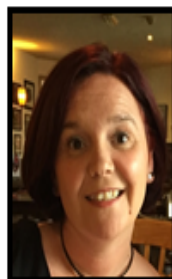

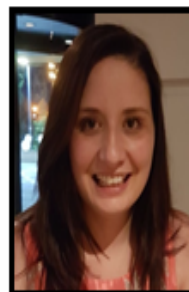

- **T** = Tell a trusted adult if you are worried or uncomfortable.

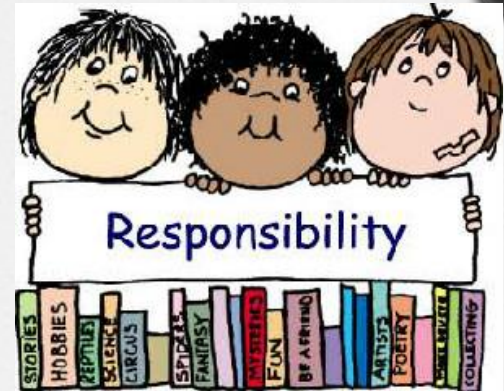

Phoneme Frames

This is another tool used in Year 3 to encourage “chunking”. Each box contains a sound.

Digraphs are **2 letters** that make a **single sound**

Children need to know the inverse of the addition sums and be able to recall out of order

$$_+3=5$$

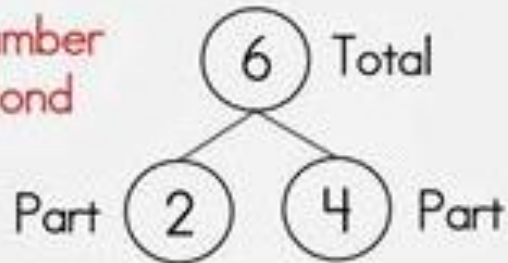

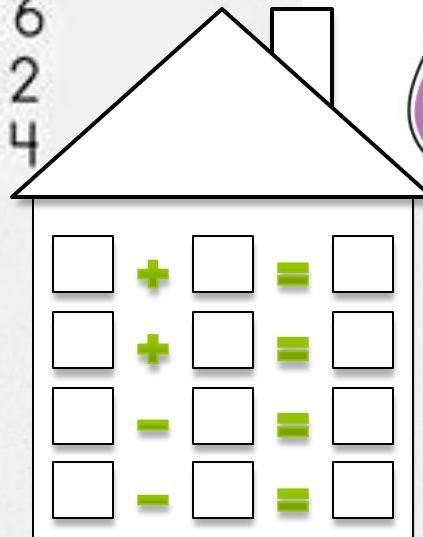
Fact Families (*number triangles*)

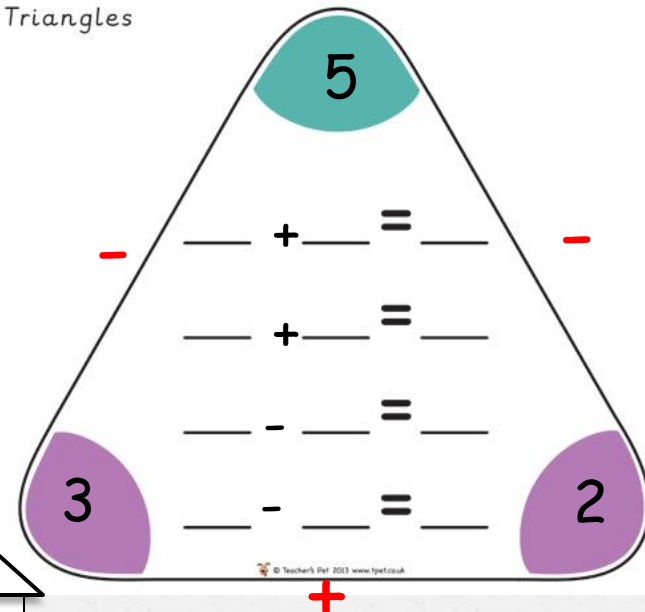
