UNCRC 30th Anniversary Competition



2019 marks the 30th anniversary of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. Over the past few years the pupils in our school have been learning all about the convention and the rights it contains. We have sent home copies of the convention which have been written and illustrated by various organisations, but to mark the 30th anniversary we would like to create our own booklet showing the articles of the convention as illustrated by our pupils.
